

The State of California's 2009 –2010 budget and related Trailer Bill (ABX4, Chapter 9, Statutes of 2009) contains statutory changes in law. Section 26: Section 4692 was added to the Welfare and Institutions Code to implement a 14-day uniform holiday schedule for specific programs and services, including transportation. The Department of Developmental Services issued a program directive adjusting the uniform holidays for Fiscal Year 2009-10. Services & Programs Impacted By Mandatory Holiday Schedule

Fiscal Year 2009-10 Mandatory 14 days Holiday Schedule:

1. *Independence Day (Observed Friday, July 3, 2009)*
2. *Labor Day (Monday, September 7, 2009)*
3. *Veterans Day (Wednesday, November 11, 2009)*
4. *Thanksgiving Day (Thursday, November 26, 2009)*
5. *Day after Thanksgiving Day (Friday, November 27, 2009)*
6. *Christmas Eve (Thursday, December 24, 2009)*
7. *Christmas Day (Friday, December 25, 2009)*
8. *Day after Christmas Day (Observed on Monday, December 28, 2009)*
9. *New Year's Day (Friday, January 1, 2010)*
10. *Martin Luther King Jr Day (Monday, January 18, 2010)*
11. *President's Day (Monday, February 15, 2010)*
12. *Cesar Chavez Day (Wednesday, March 31, 2010)*
13. *Monday, April 5, 2010 (temporary for F/Y 09-10 only - holiday will shift permanently to Columbus Day in October 2010)*
14. *Memorial Day (Monday, May 31, 2010)*

The Fiscal Year 2009-2010 mandatory Uniform Holiday Schedule would apply to the following Regional Center funded programs and services:

- Activity Center (Service Code 505)
- Adaptive Skills Trainer (Service Code 605)
- Adult Development Center (Service Code 510)
- Behavior Management Program (Service Code 515)
- Community Activities Support Services (Service Code 063)
- Client/parent Support Behavior Intervention Training Program (Service Code 048)
- Community Integration Training Program (Service Code 055)
- Creative Arts Program (Service Code 094)
- Infant Development Program (Service Code 805)
- Program Support Groups (Day Services) (Service Code 110)
- Social Recreation Program (Service Code 525)
- Socialization Training Program (Service Code 028)
- Work Activity Programs (Service Code 954)

In addition, Regional Centers shall not compensate a transportation vendor/family member (Service Code 425), transportation companies, (Service Code 875), transportation/additional component vendors (Service Code 880), transportation brokers (Service Code 883) transportation assistant/vendors (Service Code 882), transportation vendor/auto driver (Service Code 890) and transportation vendor/public or rental car agency or taxi, (Service Code 895) for transporting any consumer to receive services from any of the vendors specified above on the mandatory holiday closure days.
